### **DIGITAL HEALTH COLLABORATIVE HOSTS OPEN HOUSE**

**BEAVERTON, Ore.** – Beaverton-based Digital Health Collaborative (DHC) will host an open house on Thursday, Dec. 14 from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. at its new facility located at 4145 SW Watson Ave. This unique opportunity will allow participants to meet the people behind the programs and companies of this innovation hub for digital health and “Internet-of-Things” (IoT) technologies.
